## UNOPPOSED MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

Undersigned counsel, Paul D. Petruzzi, pursuant to D.C.Colo.L.AttyR 5(b) and Rules 1.14(a)(2), 1.14(b), 1.16(b)(5), 1.16(b)(6), and 1.16(b)(7), of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct, respectfully requests that this Honorable Court permit him to withdraw as counsel of record for the Plaintiff in this matter. In support, undersigned states as follows:

- Counsel seeks to withdraw from representing Mr. Magluta in this matter for several reasons; all grounded in the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct.
- 2. First, undersigned's professional considerations and obligations to his other clients require him to terminate his representation of Mr. Magluta. See Colo.R.P.C. 1.16(b)(5), 1.16(b)(6), and 1.16(b)(7). Because both this matter and Mr. Magluta are in Colorado and undersigned's office is in Florida, undersigned simply cannot devote the hours of representation that Mr. Magluta's matter consumes without charging him for said representation. Unfortunately, however,

Mr. Magluta and his family have failed to comply with undersigned's requests for payment. Thus, undersigned seeks to withdraw pursuant to Rules 1.16(b)(5) and 1.16(b)(6) of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct.

- 3. Additionally, Rule 1.4 of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct requires undersigned to keep Mr. Magluta informed about the status of the matter and reasonably consult with him about the means by which Mr. Magluta's objectives are to be accomplished, among other things. See Colo.R.P.C. 1.4. Indeed, and as the rule makes clear, reasonable communication between counsel and the client is absolutely necessary for the client to effectively participate in the representation. *Id.* Unfortunately, undersigned must withdraw because it has become nearly impossible for him to accomplish Mr. Magluta's objectives due to the difficulty communicating with Mr. Magluta. Mr. Magluta repeatedly cancels scheduled legal calls with undersigned. Moreover, the only communication that undersigned received from Mr. Magluta did not address the direction that Mr. Magluta wishes to proceed.<sup>1</sup>
- 4. At present, the only pending deadline concerns the filing of objections, if any, to the Report and Recommendation (DE 112). Undersigned sent Mr. Magluta the Report and Recommendation and advised him that objections are due by August 21, 2017. Accordingly, undersigned's withdrawal at this point will not affect Mr. Magluta's ability to pursue this case and Mr. Magluta will have

ample time to secure additional counsel if he wishes to do so. Indeed, Mr. Magluta

originally filed this matter, *pro se*, before retaining undersigned.

5. Furthermore, undersigned has taken reasonable steps to avoid any

foreseeable prejudice to Mr. Magluta. Contemporaneously with this filing, counsel

will send a copy of this motion and an explanatory letter to Mr. Magluta. This letter

will inform Mr. Magluta of the information mandated by D.C.Colo.L.AttyR 5(b).

Moreover, undersigned will advise Mr. Magluta that, upon the granting of this

motion, he will be responsible for complying with all court orders and time

limitations established by applicable statutes and rules.

6. Undersigned counsel conferred with Assistant United States

Attorney Mark Pestal who advised that he does not oppose the instant relief.

WHEREFORE, Undersigned counsel, Paul D. Petruzzi, respectfully

requests that this Honorable Court permit him to withdraw as counsel for the

Plaintiff in this matter.
