On March 1, 2018, This Honorable Court granted the government's request for additional time, to reply to four (4) points in my 28 U.S.C. 2255 submission; that they purposefully failed to respond to, despite this Court's ruling of no further adjournments. What is paramount is the fact that This Court Ordered the Government to respond within thirty days or by April 1, 2018, even though the government requested an additional 45 days.

As of the above date I have received no response from the government. Moreover, there is no mail distribution at this unit on Saturday or Sunday. Consequently I will not receive a copy of the government's filing until April 9, 2018 (-Monday) at the earliest.


I am not seeking nor requesting additional time or any adjournments, as I implore and plead for an expeditious determination and am confident justice will be done and my remedy granted. I only seek to inform this Court of the obvious treachery we are dealing this

The government's apathy toward rules and fundamental fairness is clearly indicative of how they prosecuted me and shun their moral and professional obligations. They intentionally delayed my receipt of their submissions because they are terrified of the truth being disclosed. They want to stymie my ability to respond.

Additionally, please be informed that once I respond to the government's legal work, my reply is submitted to the government's agent for approval; even though my submission is addressed directly to this Court, with the government's complicity my paperwork could be delayed and sit on an Agent's desk for up to fourteen (14) days. Please be cognizant of the date on my work. It delineates when I submitted it for mailing to You.

Lastly, I have submitted motions for appointment of counsel on my habeas corpus petition. I was wondering if the Court has ruled upon it.
