Dear Honorable Judge Linares:

Please accept my sincere apologies for this letter being handwritten, but we are locked in our cells and a typewriter is unavailable. Moreover, they provide two archaic manual typewriters, for a unit of 40 inmates and their use is nearly impossible. This unit, The Communications Management Unit, (CMU) is more akin to a concentration camp, than a federal prison. As a soldier I visited Abu Ghraib in Iraq and Bagram in Afghanistan and they pale in comparison to here.

I am most respectfully requesting you accept my CORRLINKS invitation, so I could emergently send communications on dire situations to

the Court.

For instance: I received the government's request for additional time to answer the 2255 and had to rely on pro bono counsel to send my ~~voicemails~~ objections, in a timely manner. The staff at this institution is also known to hold mail, even to courts and legal, causing inmates to miss their deadlines or to timely respond.

In any event, it is most respectfully requested that you consider my ~~adroit~~ objection to the government's adjournment request and compel them to answer in the time frame ordered, or forego an opportunity to respond. Additionally, I most respectfully request you accept my e-mail invitation and go on CORRELINKS to do so.

Dear Honorable Judge Linares:

Please be informed that on August 5, 2016, late in the afternoon, I received the government's adjournment request dated August 2, 2016; for their Answer to my 28 USC 2255, that is due on August 11, 2016.

I vociferously and vehemently object to any adjournments. The late nature of this motion, subsequent to my diligent and arduous efforts to comply with the Court's ordered schedule is appalling. For them to wait for the last minute, the eve of it being due and disingenuously allege that they have a trial to prepare for in September and that one of their attorney's is leaving the office is insulting me and the court; and their veiled reasons must be summarily rejected.

They had more than enough time to prepare a response and there is an inordinate amount of attorney's in their office to assist them. I have been wrongfully incarcerated and caged up like an animal for over seven years and I seek an imminent resolution of issues, that I submit should result in the reversal of my case. I am the one suffering with this travesty of justice. Most importantly, I have proposed through attorney Lustberg that I would withdraw all my motions, appeals and never file another submission, if the crucial and exclusive witness on the Kemo murder case, Anthony Young was to pass an Federal Bureau of Investigation polygraph depicting that I ever mentioned anything about harming Kemo, that I ever attended any meeting as Young alleged and that I ever uttered the words, "no Kemo no case." Moreover, I pleaded, implored and begged the prosecutor's to have Abdul Mutallic Williams and Eugene Braswell submit to polygraphs in reference to their fabricated allegations that I sold them drugs or that Williams worked as my courier. If they were to come up truthful on a polygraph, I would again agree to withdraw all motions, filings and never submit another action. I would simply submit to dying in prison.

The letter by Gay also confirms that he is one of the individuals working on my case. There are significant ethical violations, accusations of misconduct and even criminal violations asserted against him. There is clearly an appearance of impropriety averred. If Minish is assisting, which I assume he is, I most respectfully renew my motion to recues both of these members of the Newark United States Attorney's Office from working on my case. An evidentiary hearing will prove to an absolute certainty, that they suborned perjury, violated the law and Rules of Professional Responsibility. They cannot be trusted to seek justice and it will be proven that they subverted it. I submit that their judgment cannot be trusted and neutral and objective attorney's should be assigned this case.

I most respectfully request that you consider this letter/ motion with the devout sincerity to which it was written.

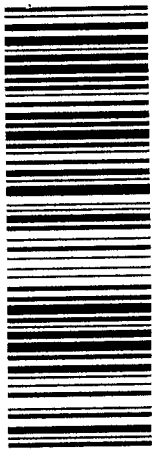
