the Court having considered the matter and good cause having been shown,

IT IS on this 22nd day of February, 2012, hereby

ORDERED that pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(a)(2)(B), Defendants, by and through their counsel, Apruzzese, McDermott, Mastro and Murphy, P.C., are hereby granted permission to undertake the deposition of Plaintiff at Northern State Prison in Newark, New Jersey, on the 5th day of March 2013, beginning at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon and continuing for up to seven (7) hours in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(d)(1); and it is further

ORDERED that the parties to this litigation are granted permission to attend Plaintiff's deposition; and it is further

ORDERED that a Court Reporter from D'Amico Certified Shorthand Reporting, LLC, retained by Defendants, may bring into Northern State Prison a stenographer machine and lap top computer, which are required to record and transcribe Plaintiff's deposition; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order shall be served upon Plaintiff within 7 days; and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon the Administrators of Northern State Prison within 7 days of the date of this Order.
