walked up to the victim and stated to him "aint you the motherfucker that was with him the other day". refering to the deceased person. Mr. Spruill told him "no that was not me". Actor then insisted that was him and pulled out handgun from his waistband. Mr. Spruill stated that before the actor had chance to pull the handgun completely out of his waistband, he fled the scene. Unknown actor fled the scene to an unknown location. Actor (mike Cassidy) remained in the area where he was ultimately apprehended by officers unit 412. The actor was transported to the robbery squad where he was slated for aggravated assault; Possession of a weapon (handgun) and possession of a weapon for unlawful purposes. Mr. Spruill was also transported to the robbery squad for a statement on the incident.

No weapon was recovered during this incident.

The undersigned detective met with the victim, Mr. Christopher Spruill. He was transported to the Robbery Squad by Sgt. O'Connor of the West District. Mr. Spruill advised me that he was on S. Orange Avenue in the area of So. 19th Street, when an unknown Black male actor pointed a handgun at him.

At this time I was advised that the Officers of Unit #412 had detained a possible actor that matches the physical description of the actor, as well as the clothing description of the actor. I advised Unit #412 to transport the possible actor to the Robbery Squad.

Once at the Robbery Squad I met with the possible actor, he gave the name of Mike Cassidy. I took the possible actor's photos (digital photo) and showed them to the complainant. The complainant made a positive identification of this actor, as being the unknown Black male actor who pointed a handgun at him. The complainant signed and dated the shown photos. The complainant then gave a formal statement to Detective Sabur of the Newark Police Homicide Squad concerning this matter.

I then checked the actor's name in the Essex County BCI computer for identification purposes. The actor was identified as Shawn McPhall (BCI photo #C200308984 & SBI #524709C). I confronted the actor with this information. He admitted to the findings and his real name. I advised the actor that he was identified as the actor of this complainant and he will be arrested for this complaint. He was advised of his Rights and arrested here at the Robbery Squad by Unit #412 (P/Os R. Oliveras & M. Cancel) for this complaint of Aggravated Assault.

This investigation is now Closed with the arrest of this actor, Mike Cassidy aka "Shawn McPhall". There was no weapon in his possession at the time of his arrest.

Mr. Spruill, I'm Detective Rashid Sabur with the Newark Police Department Homicide Unit and I would like to ask you some questions pertaining to a complaint being filed by you concerning you being approach by a man who pulled a gun out on you. According to your complaint, this incident took place on this date in the area of So. Orange Ave. and So. 19th Street around the hour of 11:45 A.M. Will you answer my questions for me truthfully and to the best of your knowledge?

Yes.
Before doing so, will you tell me for the records if the information that appears at the top of this form as it pertains to you correct? *Read out loud*

Yes.
And what is the extent of your education?
I graduated from High School. The last school I went to is West Side High School in Newark.
Can you read, write and understand the English language?

Yes.
How many brothers and sisters do you have?
I have one brother and one sister.
And what is your mother's maiden name?
Sylvia Spruill. She's gotten married and now her last name is Finkley.

How long have you lived at your current address?
I've been there for a year or something like that.
I'm now going to draw your attention to the incident I mentioned to you. Will you tell me in your own words and in full details what took place?

Me and my girlfriend Delphine went to So Orange Ave. and So. 19th Street so that she could show me where her son Kemo was killed and so that I could see the memorial they put up. While we was there a young man approached me and said: "Aint you the motherfucker that was with that guy that day". He didn't come right out and said it like that but he was pointing at the memorial so I knew he was talking about Kemo. When he asked me that I told him that I wasn't and that's when he turned to the other guys he was with and one of the guys who was with him said: yeah that's him". At that point I noticed him reach under his coat and I saw him pulling out a pistol and that's when I started running towards 13th Ave. until I got to this car lot that's on the corner of Central Ave. & So. 18th St. I tried to get the people in there to call the police for me but they told me to leave and then I ran up to the Rite Aide Pharmacy on the Corner of central Ave. & Grove St. and they called the police for me. I waited in the Rite Aide for the East Orange

Police and they came and got me. I explained to them what the situation was and they told me they were going to take me to the mini police station in Newark on So. Orange Ave. As they were driving they told me that if I was to see any of the guys, to point them out to them and they would arrest them. I was driving I did see one of the guy, the one who was asking me all the questions and pulled the gun standing on the corner of So. Orange Ave. & So. 19th St. When I saw him I pointed him out to the East Orange Officers and they were getting ready to grab him but I got scared because it was a lot of people out there and I didn't want them to see my face. I explained to them briefly what happened to my girlfriend's son on Tuesday in that area and I told them why everybody thought he was killed and that's when they took me to the mini police station on So. Orange Ave. Once they got there the Newark Police officers went back to the area where the guy was and locked him up.

Did this person your referring to at anytime pointed a gun at you?
he was reaching for it. I saw it as he was about to pull it out so I don't know if they were getting ready to rob me or shoot me because of something my girlfriend's son did. You see, my girlfriend's son worked for the Feds and he was making a lot of undercover narcotic buys for them. I don't know if he was making buys for them in that particular area but that was the area where he was killed. During the time he was killed I was locked up in the county. He was with his stepfather Johnny Davis when he was shot and me and Johnny look alike. So I don't know if the guy thought I was him or not but he kept insisting that I was the guy who was with Kemo when he was shot. It's common knowledge that people were out to kill Kemo because of what he was doing.

How well did you know Kemo?
I've been with his mother for like nineteen years. I've been knowing him that long.
Has Kemo ever told you that he was having problems with someone in the area where he was killed.
No not in the area where he got killed at but like around the end of January or the beginning of February Kemo told me that he was real scared of this guy they called E.T Hak, I don't know his real name but he's the one Kemo was scared of.

Did Kemo tell you why he was scared of this person he called E.T. Hak?
He told me that he made an undercover purchase of a lot of drugs from E.T. Hak's cousin, I don't know his name and Kemo never told me his name but he told me that he believed that they knew that he was working for the Feds. He told me that he bought the stuff off of the guy somewhere in Georgia King Village. He told me that the person he bought the drugs from was arrested by the Feds. He never said this person's name but he knew that the person was going to be coming after him because he believed they knew he was the one who set them up.

Did Kemo tell you anything else about this person you call E.T. Hak or the person who was arrested?
No.
