Petitioner William Baskerville has filed a motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 to to vacate, set aside, or correct his sentence. Presently before the Court is a motion by Petitioner seeking discovery. The government opposes the motion, but has requested that the Court defer its decision on the discovery motion until after the government files its opposition papers to the § 2255 motion because the opposition will address issues that bear on the discovery motion. The government, citing the length of the underlying trial and the number of claims Petitioner has raised, has further requested leave to file its opposition on March 21, 2014. Finding that good cause exists to support the government’s request,

IT IS on this 19th day of December, 2013,

ORDERED that the Government shall file its opposition to the § 2255 motion no later than March 21, 2014, after which time the Court will decide the discovery motion.
