This matter has come before the Court on Petitioner’s submission of a Motion to Vacate his sentence, filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. It appearing that:

1. On October 2, 2013, the Petitioner filed a Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, or Correct his sentence with this Court. (ECF No. 1.)
2. Pursuant to an Order entered by this Court (ECF No. 2), Respondents filed an Answer to the Petition. (Dkt No. 16). Petitioner thereafter filed a Reply. (ECF No. 29.)
3. The record presented to the Court, however, is incomplete.
4. Pursuant to Rule 7 of the Rules Governing § 2255 Proceedings, the Court has the authority to “direct the parties to expand the record by submitting additional materials relating to the motion.”

THEREFORE,


IT IS on this 23 day of July, 2015,

ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order, Respondents shall, pursuant to Rule 7 of the Rules Governing § 2255 Proceedings, expand the record with:

- (1) The audio recording referenced in Petitioner’s Ground I, Claim A, (ECF No. 1 at 4);

- (2) The DEA-7 forms referenced in Petitioner's Ground I, Claims D and G, (*Id.* at 4(b)-4(c));
- (3) The audio recordings referenced in Petitioner's Reply, (ECF No. 29 at 51)
- (4) The FBI 302 report referenced in Petitioner's Reply (*Id.* at 55-56); and
- (5) Trial counsels' pre-trial briefs referenced in counsels' certifications (ECF No. 16-1 ¶ 31); and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order upon Petitioner by regular U.S. mail.
