- 4. Pursuant to Rule 7 of the Rules Governing § 2255 Proceedings, the Court has the authority to "direct the parties to expand the record by submitting additional materials relating to the motion."

THEREFORE,

ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order, Respondents shall, pursuant to Rule 7 of the Rules Governing § 2255 Proceedings, expand the record with:

(1) The audio recording referenced in Petitioner's Ground I, Claim A, (ECF No. 1 at 4);

- (2) The DEA-7 forms referenced in Petitioner's Ground I, Claims D and G, (*Id.* at 4(b)-4(c));
- (3) The audio recordings referenced in Petitioner's Reply, (ECF No. 29 at 51)
- (4) The FBI 302 report referenced in Petitioner's Reply (Id. at 55-56); and

(5) Trial counsels' pre-trial briefs referenced in counsels' certifications (ECF No. 16-1 ¶ 31); and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order upon Petitioner by regular U.S. mail.
